Rules and Regulations for the Informal Use of the Rifle and Pistol Ranges

- 1. Range safety is paramount. Every member of this club is responsible for pointing out or stopping unsafe or dangerous conduct. All members will be provided a copy of the following safety guidelines and are responsible for knowing what their own responsibilities are while at the club.
- 2. Any member who sees a violation that is ongoing or is not rectified, or the offending members is unwilling to curb their conduct, should provide that information to a club officer, including the name/description of the member committing the violation
- 3. All members should practice good range etiquette:
 - 1. All firearms should be treated as if they are loaded
 - 2. Firearms should not be loaded until you are in your shooting station and it is safe to engage your target.
 - 3. No one is permitted forward of the firing line or downrange unless all guns are safe, clear, cased, holstered, or resting on the able with actions open. Firearms may not be handled when someone is downrange posting targets or forward of the firing line.
 - 4. All shooters should be aware of the movement of others on the range,
 - 5. Shooters should be evenly spaced to form a safe firing line
 - 6. Ear and eye protection is strongly recommended
 - 7. No centerfire rifles are permitted on the pistol range.
- 4. Automatic firearm use is not permitted on any Norwottuck Range.
- 5. Incendiary, armor piercing, or tracer ammunition is not permitted.

- 6. No alcohol or drugs are permitted on the range at any time. No shooting for any member once alcoholic beverages have been consumed.
- 7. You are responsible for your own trash. Targets, Empty cartridge boxes and related trash should be removed by the member who brought it to the range.
- 8. The shooting of non-target items is prohibited. This includes but not limited to: televisions, paint cans, computers, glass of any kind, rocks, fruits/vegetables, or furniture.
- 9. Minors 16 and under must be under the care and in the company of an adult member at all times.
- 10. Membership applications are available in the club house every Sunday, 8AM 1PM. There is no sharing of memberships: each shooter must posses their own card that must be displayed at all times while on the range
- 11. Shooting times are 9AM to Sunset
- 12. All targets must be elevated off of the ground at the minimum by three feet to the center of the target, with a maximum of five feet in hight
- 13. Shooters are responsible for providing their own targets and target frames
- 14. The rifles and pistol range will be closed to allow for clay target shooting during the following times with no exception:
 - 1. Sunday, 9AM to 1PM. Competition shoots may extend the hours beyond 1PM
 - 2. Tuesdays, 12PM to 4PM (April-October)
- 15. All members are responsible for opening, closing and locking the gate.
- 16. All rules are subject to change.

A violation of the rules may revoke any membership

Gate Protocol

- 1. Members must close and lock the gate upon entering and leaving the grounds.
- 2. Members encountering non-members using the range should inform them that the range is for members only and ask them to leave. The encounter should be reported to a club officer with a description and license plate number if possible.
- 3. As with all rules violations, a club member who is delinquent in locking the gate should be reported to a club officer.
